Prof Siphamandla Zondi - Moderator

Prof Zondi holds a PhD in African Studies from the University of Cambridge. He has 22 years of experience in the research environment, from his position as a researcher on SADC integration and liberation movements at the Africa Institute of South Africa (AISA) in 2001 to his position as Head of the Institute for Global Dialogue between 2010 and 2016. In December 2021, he was reappointed to the National Planning Commission by the President of the Republic of South Africa, His Excellency - Mr Cyril Ramaphosa, where he leads work on international dimensions of development planning. He also serves as the Chair of the South African BRICS Think Tank.



Dr Angelique G. Nindi - Panellist

Dr Nindi is an Economics Lecturer at the University of Eswatini with a decade of academic experience. She holds a PhD in Economics from Rhodes University, MA in Economics, and a BA in Economics and Accounting from the University of Botswana.
